The holder of this license is certified as able to jumpmaster other licensed parachutists and pack his own main parachute; may participate in National and International Record Attempts; may participate in USPA and FAI sanctioned competitions; make relative-work, night, water and exhibition jumps in accordance with the USPA Basic Safety Regulations; is eligible for USPA Jumpmaster, Instructor and Instructor/Examiner Ratings; and is eligible for appointment as a USPA Club Safety Officer or USPA Area Safety Officer.

ANNUAL VALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

- a. Be a current member of the United States Parachute Association; and
