US/FAI CLASS D LICENSE PRIVILEGES

The holder of this license has completed a minimum of 200 controlled freefall parachute jumps to include delayed falls of up to at least 60 seconds. The holder of this license is certified as able to jumpmaster other licensed parachutists and pack his own main parachute; may participate in National and International Record Attempts; may participate in USPA and FAI sanctioned competitions; make relative-work, night, water and exhibition jumps in accordance with the USPA Basic Safety Regulations; is eligible for USPA Jumpmaster, Instructor and Instructor/Examiner Ratings; and is eligible for appointment as a USPA Club Safety Officer or USPA Area Safety Officer.

ANNUAL VALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

This license should be validated each calendar year. To validate this US/FAI Class D Expert Parachutist License the holder must:

- Be a current member of the United States Parachute Association; and
- Have completed 10 controlled delayed freefall parachute jumps during the preceding 12-month period.

Pilots and all aviation officials are encouraged to assist the holder of this license in any manner necessary to promote and encourage safe parachuting activities.

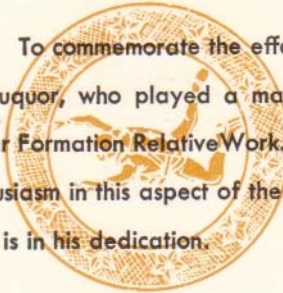
